Score Card for Visual Hay Quality Evaluation to Determine Relative Feed Value (RFV)

Use this chart to assist the horse owner with a visual estimate when evaluating hay quality. Although not as reliable as forage testing, these guidelines for sensory evaluation are given. Hay that is cut early, leafy, soft, green, free of foreign material and has a pleasant odor, will be high quality and have a high Relative Feed Value (RFV).
