
Make a plan; include alternate plans and routes - and practice!

Plan should be scalable depending on the number of people available to assist.

In the event of a fire contact emergency response and always put human safety above animal safety.

BARN WITH STALL DOORS OPEN TO CENTRE AISLE

Option 1 - Run out lane from centre aisle



- 1) Open paddock gate
- 2) Have a permanent fence (or a temporary fence or bright rope)
- 3) Close end doors
- A) Release horses, encourage and give cues to exit the open end door, close end barn door
- 5) Close paddock gate after all horses are inside
