


Make a plan; include alternate plans and routes - and practice!

In the event of a fire contact emergency response and always put human safety above animal safety.


BARN WITH STALL DOORS OPEN TO OUTSIDE

PADDOCK



- 1) From outside, close barn doors
- 2) Catch and halter** horse, hand off to 2nd (3rd etc) person
- 3) Lead to paddock, close gate, REPEAT

** Emergency halter and lead on outside stall doors
