FIRE PREVENTION OUTREACH PROGRAM FOR RACING

Equine Guelph would like to announce a wonderful opportunity for members of the racing industry. During the summer of 2016 a pilot program will be introduced for horse farms involved in the racing industry; including thoroughbred, standardbred and quarterhorse racing, whether racing, training or breeding. A limited number of visits will be scheduled for farms interested in having a fire prevention professional walk through their facility, providing a valuable assessment and recommendations to maximize safety.

2016 - THE YEAR OF BIOSECURITY New Arrivals and Returning Horses



Horses that play together, stay together, according to the new **National Farm-Level Biosecurity standard**.

There is always a risk of new and returning horses bringing a pathogen back to the herd but there are many precautions to help minimize this risk such as keeping horses that travel on the same circuits in the same groups and separating horses that are new to the farm. Equine Guelph has fact sheets outlining [precautions for the traveling horse](#) and [tips on how to manage new and returning horses](#).

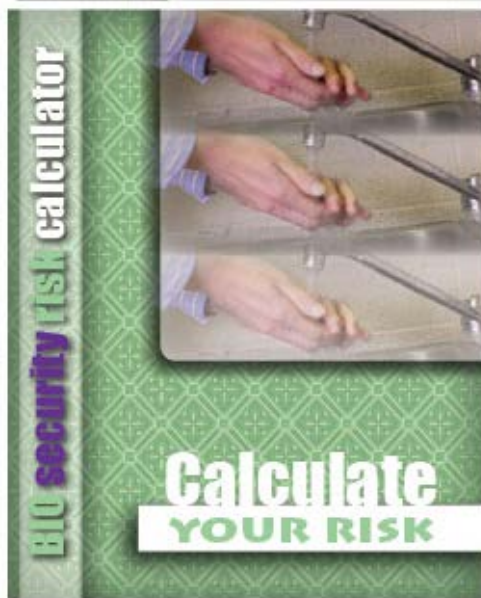
