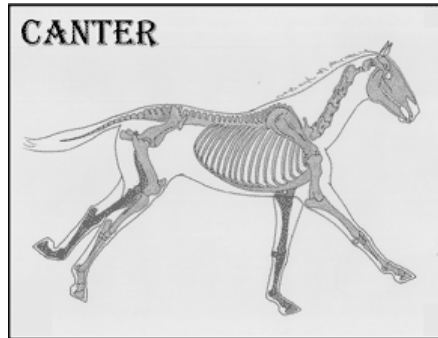
Celebrating Somebeachsomewhere
