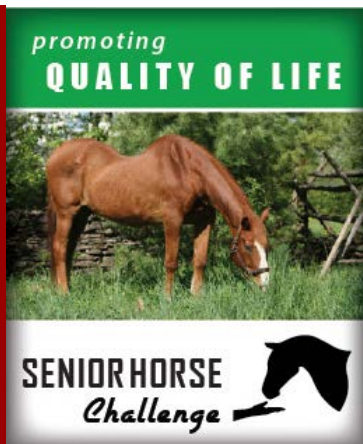

Healthcare Tool of the Month - Senior Horse Challenge
